ETGSA has determined that it does have documents responsive to your request.

With respect to ETGSA policies concerning water credit calculation, transfers of credits, landowner discretion regarding priorities, and carryover, are prescribed by ETGSA's Rules & Regulations. The Rules & Regulations are made available to the public on ETGSA's website, and are available at <https://easterntulegsa.com/wp-content/uploads/2023/09/2023-05-04-ninth-amended-rules-regulations-full.pdf>. With respect to "one-time" measures related to groundwater accounting, please see the following emergency ordinance passed in 2021: <https://easterntulegsa.com/wp-content/uploads/2023/09/2021-05-25-emergency-ordinance-no.-2021-01.pdf>.

Regarding your other request, made pursuant to Government Code section 7927.410(e), ETGSA has determined that it has documents responsive to the request. However, please note that the exemption extends only to those persons who serve as public officials. Accordingly, the agency's production will be limited to the records of actual office holders under section 7927.410(e). Records of landowners who are not themselves office holders are exempt from production under section 7927.410.
