To continue providing **safe, clean, reliable water** to our communities, Cal Water has proposed our **Infrastructure Improvement Plan for 2025-2027**.

Our future upgrades will strengthen:



Reliability

- **Replace 78,445 feet of water main** to prevent failure of aging and high-risk pipelines



Safety

- **Upgrade existing water treatment facility** to deliver safe, clean drinking water



Supply

- Install new **2.25 million-gallon** storage tank and well
- Install new **water main under the Kern River** to more effectively and efficiently use existing surface water supplies

For these important upgrades and costs to maintain and operate this system, under this proposal, the typical customer using 8,976 gallons of water per month would have an **increase of 29 cents per day beginning in 2026, followed by 15 cents per day in 2027 and 17 cents per day in 2028**.
