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Hi Amer,

Thanks for reaching out. Concerning reporting timelines, the Board postponed the reporting deadline from December 1, 2025, until May 1, 2026, for non-de minimis groundwater pumpers. The reporting period is set by statute (Water Code section 5202), which requires reporting starting 90 days after the probationary designation, which was July 15, 2024. Given the October 30

decisions from the Fifth District Court of Appeal, the Board postponed the reporting deadline to avoid confusion among extractors about when reports would be due. The appellate decisions are not yet

final. We will provide further clarification and updates on deadlines and reporting details as appropriate.

Please note that the Kings County Farm Bureau has disputed the Board's ability to postpone the reporting deadline, let alone conduct discussions with the GSAs. In addition, the Farm Bureau has filed a petition for review for one of the appellate decisions with the California Supreme Court. Regrettably, given the highly contentious litigation, the State Water Board will not be meeting with local GSAs at this time. We will let you know when a meeting is feasible.
